Basic information


- Age range 6 -14 years

- What to Bring Parents are asked to equip their children with suitable clothes and footwear for the weather. A spare set of clothes, wellies, sunscreen and a packed lunch. We will provide PPE for the children partaking in building activities.
- Course Details. Over the 6 weeks the children will get to partake in a range of Forest School, outdoor and traditional building activities. These activities will all take place at the Greenlanes Education Centre, in small, age appropriate groups with our experienced forest school practitioners. The children will have an opportunity to explore the woods, meadow and orchard, have fun making new friends and acquire new skills and confidence.

Activities for Older Children...

The children will all be working together on site in mixed age groups and all will get to be involved in the construction of the roundhouse. We do however have activities that will be reserved for the older students (10+). All of these activities will be risk assessed by the students themselves and all Personal Protective equipment will be provided by the centre

The children will have the opportunity to learn how to use basic hand tools, them to put their new found skills to use.





They will help reinforce the structure with struts, build hazel and cob walls to protect it from the elements, research and decide what roof to put on the roundhouse. The children will have an opportunity to make a very real contribution to the building of this impressive structure.
